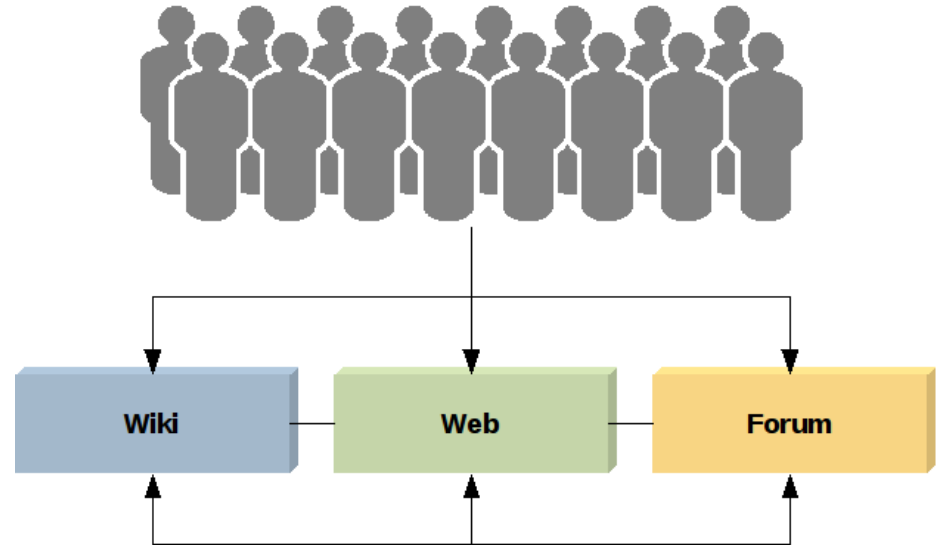

ooo.doc Objectives

- Create easy **user access**
- Allow easy **contribution**
- Ensure **targeted content**
- Ensure documentation is **up-to-date** and technically **accurate**
- Be **efficient**, minimize duplication of efforts
- Implement **transparent processes**
- Include all **locales**

User Access

- Wiki (Doc)
 - > 300,000 monthly page views
- Forum
 - > 4,500 monthly postings
- Website (Doc)
 - > 200,000 monthly page views
- Cross-links between the access channels



DocWiki: Where Are We?

- **New Additions since OOoCon 2007**
 - > 411 new HowTos and References (many of them by DrKing)
 - > All OOoAuthors docs for OOo2.x
 - > New OOoAuthors docs for OOo3.0
- **New localized manuals are available on the Wiki:**
 - > Chinese Developer's Guide
 - > French, Chinese and Japanese Administration guide (in progress)
 - > French, Chinese and Japanese BASIC Guide (in progress)
- **New functionality since OOoCon 2007**
 - > Language InterWiki links
 - > Update to MW 1.11
 - > New extensions: Collections, WikiMath, Language Selector, IDL tags, Displaytitle

DocWiki: What's Missing?

- **A Concise Editing Policy**
 - > To support consistent look, feel, and style
 - > Martina is working on that (mwaller@openoffice.org)
- **A Set of Templates**
 - > To support consistent structure and easier localization
 - > Martina is working on that (mwaller@openoffice.org)
- **Localization Policy and Templates**
 - > To support consistent experience across languages
 - > Needs to be worked at with NLC
- **What else?**
 - > Wiki Access Rights, Wiki Areas for NLC or Projects with rights to delete, functionality?

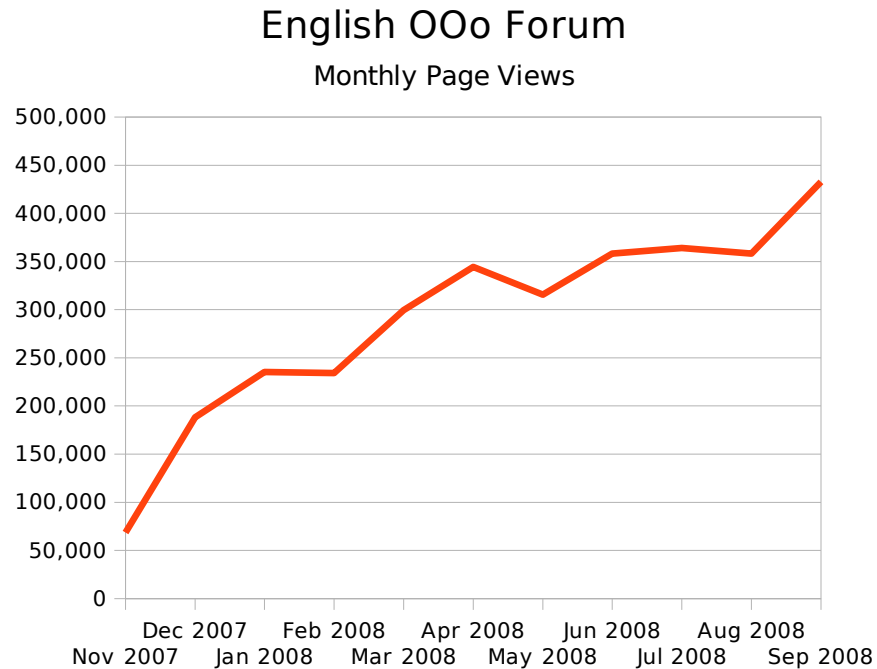
Forum: Facts

- The OpenOffice.org User forum is managed entirely by members of the OpenOffice.org User community.
- Localized forums:
 - > French, Hungarian, Japanese, and more languages coming soon
- Get involved as contributor, volunteer, administrator or help start a localized forum

Forum: Statistics

- Status of Forum

- > User Forum went live on 17 November 2007
- > 53,000 posts in 11,000 topics by more than 12,000 members



DocWebsite: Facts

- Nowadays, the collaboration platform is the DocWiki
- DocWebsite as repository for static content and snapshots
- OpenOffice.org 3.0 Conceptual Guide
 - > Contributed by Gabriel Gurley
 - > Provides educational guides and training materials
 - > Awarded with Sun award
- OOoAuthors
 - > New OOo3.0 guides

- Developer Documents

Include all Locales

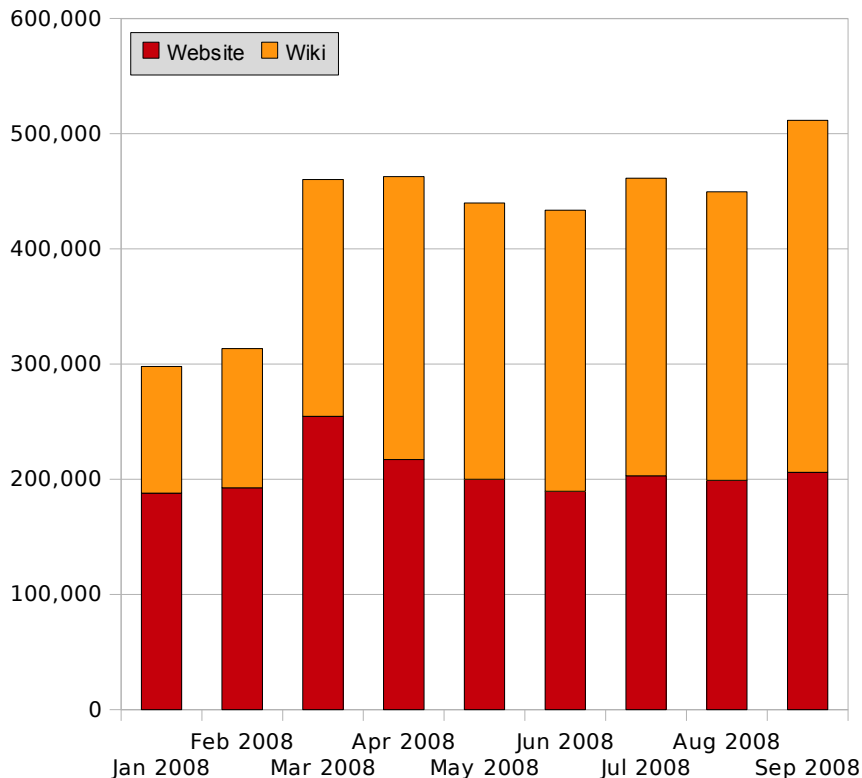
- Working on it

Ease of Contribution

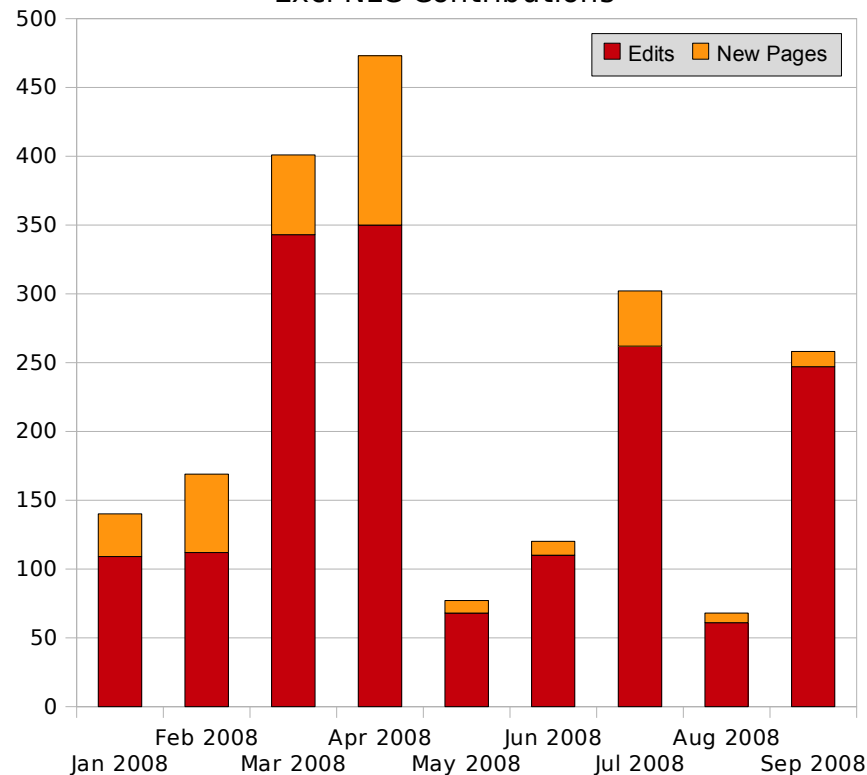
- Type of Wiki Contributions
 - > Comment on an existing page
 - > Edit an existing page (modify, add content)
 - > Categorize an existing page
 - > Create external content and link to it through the Wiki
- The only requirement to edit or comment on Wiki pages:
 - > Get registered with the Wiki
- What could be made easier?

Wiki: Outlook

- PediaPress extension
 - > Creating ODF and PDF from aggregated Wiki pages
 - > Allow print-on-demand from Wiki documents
- InterWiki links
 - > Link content from different languages easily and transparently
- Localization progress and process (eg using ISO language codes)
- MediaWiki Engine Upgrade
- Other New Functionality
 - > Flagged Revisions to improve reliability and accuracy
 - > WYSIWYG Wiki editor

 - > Validation of content
 - > Consistency of style and look
