- Example for the benefits of extensions in integration solutions
- Goal: Yet another CMS – but easy to use and easy to implement
- In fact a Documentation Management System
- Forrest – a publishing framework from the Apache project
- OpenOffice.org as “rich client” / GUI for a CMS

...not so easy



- Site structure and configuration in XML-files
- Remembering the special notation of links and styles
- Hierarchy of headings and subheadings
- Where to set the title
- Where to put the files
- Installation and prerequisites

How could we fill the gaps?



- Installation and prerequisites should be done by the Extension with user-interaction
- Files should be stored according to the site-structure
- Document Title should be asked
- Warning for wrong heading hierarchy
- Assistant for link insertion
- Pre-built styles should be delivered
- Visual editing of the site-structure
